If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, New Paths, Inc. wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job!
- It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

New Paths, Inc. offers **multiple** ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Report to any New Paths, Inc. staff member, volunteer, contractor and/or administrator.
- Submit a condition of residency, grievance or recipient rights claim with New Paths, Inc.
- Report to the PREA Coordinator, Executive Director, James Hudgens.
